Re: Shared Pathway Improvements on San Marco Road

Dear Mr. Pinter:

Calusa Garden Club of Marco Island was founded in 1982, and at that time, one of our founding principles was protection of the environment. Now, in 2020, that principle is more important to us and to all Marco Island residents than ever before.

The City of Marco Island is in the final process of the construction of a shared pathway from San Marco Road/South Barfield Drive to the Marco Island Academy. The Bike Path Committee has been working on these projects with funds from FDOT Grants. The wide sidewalks or shared-use pathways are shared by both cyclists and pedestrians and will add to the "walkability" factor of our community.

Once the shared pathways are completed on San Marco Road, the swales will need to be planted with vegetation to control erosion. In the past, turf has been used and we think that City's normal planting of sod in the public right of ways is not considered to be environmentally friendly. Grass or turf requires water, fertilizer, and frequent maintenance to become established.

We at Calusa Garden Club of Marco Island advocate the use of eco-friendly alternatives such as perennial peanut or sunshine mimosa in the public rights of ways. These groundcovers can be mowed and require less maintenance once established. Using one of these groundcovers along that stretch of San Marco Road would be the ideal eco-friendly "turf" alternative so close to the mangroves. And, both plants produce colorful flowers that will enhance the landscape and the experience of cyclists and walkers using the shared pathway.

Please consider our recommendations for a more beautiful and environmentally friendly Marco Island.
