Garden/Leigh Plummer Park**

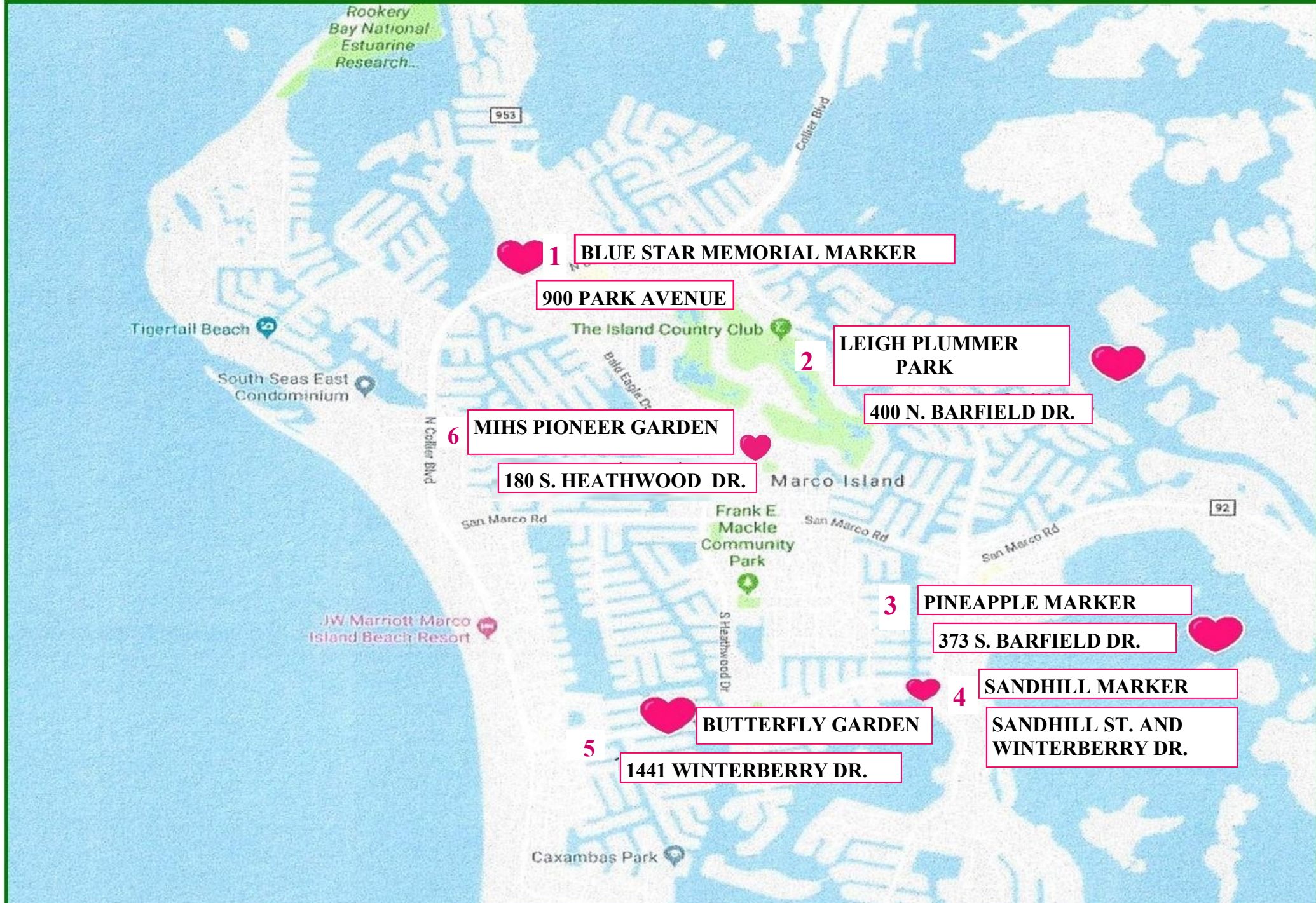
400 N. Barfield Drive
